

Umpiring is challenging, everyone expects you to get it right. With support, training and desire to be the best you can be, the rewards are amazing.

DDNA Umpire "Musts"

- 1. Netball Victoria Registration https://vic.netball.com.au/netball-victoria-membership/
- 2. If aged 18 plus, must have a Working With Children Check https://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/
- 3. Completion and return of Tax Department Hobby Job form and DDNA Umpire Details Form
- 4. Umpire "uniform" as prescribed by DDNA in carrying out DDNA Umpiring responsibilities
- 5. Current Rules of Netball
- 6. Own whistle and a spare, and bands for keeping centre pass
- 7. Suitable sports footwear
- 8. Personal items e.g. hair ties etc.

DDNA Umpire Responsibilities

- 1. Recognize that players rely on the Umpires to administer the rules as effectively and fairly as they can. That is what you are there for.
- 2. Arrive with sufficient time to be ready in correct gear, report to the Umpire Co-ordinator, who will mark you off and receive your Court allocation/s.
- 3. Attend "Rules in Action" meetings as organized by the Umpire Supervisor and Umpire Co-ordinator.
- 4. Regularly read through your Rule Book
- 5. Be responsible for diarising any future DDNA umpiring appointments, including Saturdays, Tuesday night competition, or Tournaments for which you accept appointments.

DDNA Responsibilities

- 1. It is your right to honour your Umpiring appointments in a safe environment. If you have any problems or issues, you are to report immediately to the Umpire Supervisor or Co-ordinator, or send someone to advise the Umpire Supervisor or Co-ordinator to attend to your Court.
- 2. Remuneration
 - a. The Umpire Co-ordinator will supply relevant Umpire Appointment information for all Saturday appointments, except for 17/Under and Open Age divisions, to the DDNA Finance Officer, and payment will be effected by EFT fortnightly.
 - b. The Umpire Co-ordinator will supply relevant Umpire Appointment information for all Saturday appointments for 17/Under and Open Age divisions to the relevant Clubs, who will organize payment by EFT fortnightly or weekly, depending on their finance arrangements.
